#### **DRCC Cornerstone Fellowship Update**

Cornerstone Fellowship was formed this year to help maintain, strengthen, and protect our church home. Why?

In 2024, Deep River Congregational Church needed full roof replacement, structural repairs, and maintenance of the church, bell tower, sanctuary and parsonage. Work is ongoing and will cost more than \$200,000.

Cornerstone Fellowship supporters are helping DRCC to cover the cost, avoid long-term interest payments, and seed a fund to cover future building maintenance.

To date, Cornerstone Fellowship members have pledged \$156,000 with \$146,000 paid. We hope more will join in helping us reach our goal!
