In 2024 and into 2025, Deep River Congregational Church is in need of full roof replacement, structural repairs, and maintenance of the church, bell tower, sanctuary and parsonage. Work is ongoing and will cost more than \$200,000.

Cornerstone Fellowship supporters are helping DRCC to cover the cost, avoid long-term interest payments, and seed a fund to cover future building maintenance.

To date, 67 Cornerstone Fellowship members have pledged \$159,143 with \$151,143 paid. We hope more will join in helping us reach our goal!
